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

Hospitals as a STRONG VOICE




Why the study: Chronic Disease in Children...?

* Interferes in the long term child's development


Quality of Health services for children with Type 1 Diabetes ?

How do Health services interact with Social Structures to guarantee the quality of services ?







Challenges to the therapeutic education of Child International Society for Paediatric A Di

Social Networks: the way individuals are connected may be critical



Well connected individuals may have more influential role [time, trust, reciprocity]

Weakly connected individuals involves occasional transactions, in which the identity of the individuals has less importance [minimum levels of trust, reciprocity]

The diagnosis and analysis of existing social networks: as innovative & complex


• To verify and analyze which are the limitations of the existing social networks

Purpose: to analyze the existing social networks for the support to children with Type 1 Diabetes on Barreiro





"Weighted" Network of formal contacts in the treatment of the Child with Diabetes




Analysis of Results: In any social network there are ties with close relationship




